## Discussion

- Review the goals for Mar 2018 – Feb 2019 for Erik Deumens and Research Computing by the CIO:
  - o Maintain HiPerGator: address need for GPUs and other needs like refresh of several ancillary servers that are reaching end of life.
  - o Communication campaign to make sure HiPerGator and ResVault is in the awareness of faculty and administrators.
  - o Explore the use of the public cloud and set up enterprise agreements for Azure, Google, AWS, and IBM.
  - o Create training for research facilitation for central and distributed IT staff to learn how to support researchers better to start in fall of 2018.
  - o Develop a grant program for faculty in the humanities and social sciences with few researches to pay for use of HiPerGator and ResVault
  - o Develop the UFIT Fellows programs for CISE junior and senior students to start in fall 2018.
  - o Make national presentations about what UF is doing in research computing.
  - o Apply for external funding.
- RC is developing a process for onboarding research projects into ResVault with all offices at UF involved in supporting researchers who work with restricted data: ISO, O Research, Privacy, IRB, etc.
